LONDON, Oct. 2.--The papers yesterday all had long editorials on the Volunteer's victory Friday. The Telegraph says: "We are whipped. The Volunteer has, for the second time, beat the Thistle and that cup which it was hoped and prayed by every Briton that she would recover must now remain in the United States."

The Chronicle regards the defeat as conclusive and remarks that the defeat must be accepted with good grace. The Sportsman looks on the result as a defeat of the most decisive character, and adds: "It has now been demonstrated that the type of yachts built on the American side are much swifter than those constructed in Great Britain."

The Fish Commissioners.

State fish commissioners Thompson and Campbell left yesterday afternoon for the salmon hatchery on the Clackamas river. The former said the dam there had been injured somewhat and will need repairs, but nevertheless there is considerable water. Last Thursday there were 200,000 eggs in the hatchery and additions are being made at the rate of 30,000 to 50,000 a day.
