Within the last sixty days, Australian freights from the Sound have advanced ten shillings per thousand feet of lumber. This is explained by stating that during last year while freights were good to the colonies, several large fleets of Norwegian vessels rushed to the Sound and overstocked the market with unchartered vessels. In consequence thereof vessels could not get a charter for fortytwo shillings. While this condi-tion of freights was in effect the Norwegian owners made other arrangements for their vessels When this was effected the prices of lumber steadily advanced in in the colonies and the demand became greater, and, as stated before, the Norwegians could not, owing to having been chartered previously for other foreign reights, return to the Sound. Again, on the other hand, the

This fact is clearly demonstrated by freights going up to Port Townsend Correspondence Seattle Post-Intelligencer.


