A MEMBER of the legislature of Nova Scotia has been expelled from that body for hiring carriages to convey voters to the polls.

BROOKLYN cast a tremendous vote yesterday. In 1884 there was a registration of 127,704 votes and this time the number aggregated 129,688.

THIRTY thousand persons were thrown out of employment at Nashua, N. H., because a muskrat dug a hole in a canal bank, which resulted in the breaking of an embankment and a rush of water.

The board of education at Kingston, Ont., has issued an order under the public school laws expelling from the public schools all Roman Catholic children whose parents are supporters of a separate school system.

BETWEEN \$8,000 and \$10,000 of the money raised in St. Louis for the entertainment of the Grand Army men in that city was not expended, and it is now proposed to use it to secure the national political conventions that will meet next year.

The continuous decrease of crime in England is very remarkable. So recently as 1869 the prisons contained no less than 11,500 convicts. In July last there were only 7,441. The education act marked the turning point in the history of crime. Since the passage of that act the decrease of crime has been steady.

The latest at this hour, (3:30 A. M.) is that prohibition is being voted in this state by about 7,000 majority. Probably a finer day than yesterday would have permitted a larger vote, and an even more emphatic refusal on the part of Oregon to accept the idea. The vote speaks for itself. As in Michigan, Tennessee, and Texas, so this progressive state refuses to submit to cast iron dogma and by so doing shows that the spirit of American freedom is not lacking in this commonwealth.

FROM EUROPE AND THE EAST

CHICAGO, Nov. 8.—A loaded dynamite bomb was found this morning on the west side near the polling place. The bomb was made out of gaspipe. A letter postmarked San Francisco, with the stamp date of Nov. 3rd, reached the jail at noon, addressed to "Messrs. Spies, Schwab, and all noble men and patriots misnamed anarchist prisoners." It was handed up to Spies. Another search of cells this morning was made with the result of the finding of a red cord three or four feet long in Lugg's cell. The cord was long and strong enough to have permitted the use of it for strangling purposes. The wives and friends of the doomed men were not admitted to the jail this morning, this being a holiday.

A FINE BRIDGE. POUHKEEPSIE, Nov. 8.—The first truss of the great bridge across the Hudson river was finished and swung clear yesterday. It is 525 feet long between centers of towers and is the largest and heaviest steel truss in the world. It rests on steel towers.

A FATAL CAVE. COSHOCTON, Ohio, Nov. 8.—The tunnel of the Dresden branch of C. A. & C. railroad, twelve miles west of here is reported caved in last night and six men killed and several wounded.

GREAT FIRE LOSSES. NEW YORK, Nov. 8.—The Commercial Bulletin's fire record for October, shows the losses in the United States and Canada to be \$9,770,000. The total for the first ten months of the current year foot up \$102,553,409.

A STORM AT SEA. LONDON, Nov. 8.—The steamer City of Chester arrived at Queenstown, encountered a terrific gale on the voyage lasting from the 3rd to the 6th. Immense seas swept the deck and two life boats were crushed.

IMPROVING IN HEALTH. BERLIN, Nov. 8.—Prof. Bergmann will perform the operation on the throat of the crown prince if his physicians decide that such a step is necessary. The emperor though worried about the condition of the crown prince, is improving in health.

MOONLIGHTERS. DUBLIN, Nov. 8.—A party of disguised moonlighters forced an entrance into a house near Tralee, county Kerry, last night and shot the owner, named Quirk, in presence of his family.

GOING BACK. LONDON, Nov. 8.—The czar and his family will leave Copenhagen on the 12th inst., on their return to St. Petersburg.

FROM THE EAST. NEW YORK, Nov. 8.—The very latest returns from Pennsylvania show that the state has gone Republican by twenty thousand majority.

VIRGINIA. In Virginia forty cities and towns heard from returns show that the Democrats have the house by two thirds majority and the senate by three-fourths; this insures the election of a Democratic U. S. senator to succeed Riddleberger.

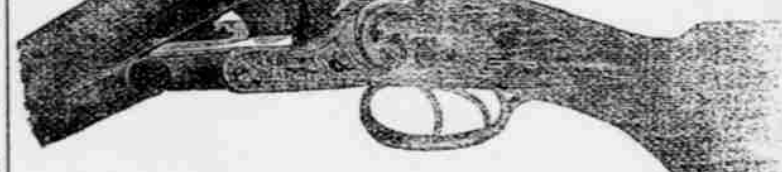
