An Important Event. SAN FRANCISCO, Nov. 25.—Mayor Pond, chairman of the committee of the board of trade appointed to arrange for a proper celebration of the California & Oregon line, has called a meeting for tomorrow evening.

An opinion is expressed by Port and people that arrangements should be made to have a portion of the programme celebrated in Portland. It is believed from all that can be learned thus far that a grand excursion from San Francisco to Portland and return will form a conspicuous feature of the celebration.

There are still nine miles of track to be laid on the northern grade of Siskiyou mountains before there will be any connection with the track at Ashland. This work will take at least a week, so its not likely that connection will be effected by the 1st prox., as anticipated.
