Important Decision as to Interest on Motes

In a Washington territory district court lacely a judgement was asked upon a note by the terms of which interest was to 5 paid at the rate of 10 per cent, a year until the sr. Louis. due day of the note, and 2 per cent, per month after that day. The court decided that the 2 per cent per month clause was in the nature of a penalty, and could not be enforced at law.

Through earelessness in direction 18,000 letters per day reached the dead letter office this year. Of the whole 5,000,000, money was found in 17,745 amounting to \$28,-687. 


