The name is derived from the largest river which flows through the proposed territory. This land appears on the ways at the interior depart. on the maps at the interior department as "public lands." It is a parallelogram thirty miles wide, larger than the state of Delaware and nearly as large as New Jersey. It is bounded on the north by Colorado and Kansas, on the east by Indian territory, on the south by Texas, and on the west by New Mexico. The Cimarron river rises near its southwestern boundary and empties into the Arkansas river in the Indian territory. Cimarron territory came into the possession of the United States in 1819, under what is known as the Florida treaty with Spain, by which treaty we secured Florida, but lost Texas. The proposed territory of Cimarron is the most symmetrical division of the United States. Not far to the south of it, in Texas and New Mexico, is the high table land known as the Llano Estacado, or "staked plains," which forms the eastern base of the Rocky mountains and rises to the height of over two thousand feet. The vote of the new delegate will be Democratic.
