Mayor and Common Council of the City of Astoria: GENTLEMEN: We, the undersigned property owners along the line of Cedar street between West Sixth street and Salmon street, respectfully request the proposed improvement of said street according to the notice as published, a copy of which is hereto attached.

Cedar Street Improvement Notice. NOTICE is hereby given that the Common Council of the City of Astoria, Oregon, propose to order the improvement of that portion of Cedar street, in the City of Astoria, Clatsop county, Oregon, as laid out and recorded by J. M. Shirey, from the east side of West Sixth street to the east side of Salmon street, by replacing all existing sidewalks with new sidewalks, and by widening the sidewalks with new and sound iron planks four inches in thickness, to a width of thirty feet from the center thereof, and an improvement to be made to the established grade of said street, and unless a remonstrance signed by the owners of two-thirds of the property fronting on said portion of said street be filed with the Auditor and Police Judge within ten days of the final publication of this notice, to wit: on or before Tuesday, February 7th, 1888, the Common Council will order said improvement to be made.

Conscience Stricken. The secretary of the treasury has received a letter dated Fitchburg, Mass., enclosing a 25 cent silver piece, which the sender desired to have placed in the treasury to the credit of conscience. In the note transmitting the coin he says: 'To whom it may concern: Once upon a time, some thirty years ago, in a spirit of evil-mindedness—or perhaps because I could, though even at the time I knew better—I took it upon me to obliterate the cancelling marks of a five-cent postage stamp and use it again. And, though no mortal may ever have been aware of it I have known it all the while. Under the Mosaic dispensation a restitution of one-fifth was deemed requisite to satisfy the claims of justice in the case of trespass. So here: One-fifth of five is one, and one to five makes six. At 6 per cent a sum is doubled in about sixteen years, and this then amounted to twelve cents; and doubled again amounts to twenty-four cents. Now to give the government the benefit of the fraction I enclose twenty-five cents. LOYAL CITIZEN.

The Oyster Interest. Few people realize what an immense industry the oyster interest is. Returns show that the annual oyster product of the country is worth about thirteen millions of dollars. It employs 53,000 persons and over \$10,500,000 capital. It is worth three times as much as the cod fishery, four times as much as the salmon, six times as much as the menhaden, and over ten times as much as the shad and alewife fishery together. And yet the oyster business is only in its infancy.—Fishing Gazette.
