To Relieve Settlers.

The senate has passed a bill the urport of which is to relieve cerain settlers of public lands, and to provide for the repayment of certain fees, purchase money, and of public land. It provides that the mind, and at night the werries, commissions paid on void entries in all cases where homestead, preemption, or timber culture, or desert land entries or other entries of public lands have heretofore or shall hereafter be canceled for conflict, or where, from any cause, the entry has been erroneously allowed and eannot be confirmed. the secretary of the interior shall cause to be repaid to the person who made such entry, or to his heirs or assigns, the tees and commissions, amount of purchase money, and excess paid upon the same, upon the surrender of the duplicate receipt and the execution of a proper relinquishment of all claims to said land, whenever II Waco Steam Havigation Co such entry shall have been duly canceled by the commissioner of the general land office, and in all cases where parties have paid which has afterwards been found not to be within the limits of : railroad land grant, the excess of \$1.25 per acre shall in like manner be repaid to the purchaser thereof or to the heirs of assigns: Provided, That in all cases of pre emption or commuted homestead entries, in which from any cause the patent cannot be issued, and in which it shall be satisfactorily shown that the entry was made in good faith and without fraud, and was paid for with the money of a third party acting in good faith and without fraud, and that he has not been reimbursed therefor, the money shall be refunded to such third party on the cancellation of the entry, upon the sur render of the duplicate receipt and the execution by him of a proper relinquishment of all claims to said lands.


