Alaska Seal and Salmon.

Washington, Mar. 3.—The bill for the better protection of the salmon and seal fisheries of Alaska, which passed both houses, provides that the president of the United States shall issue a proclamation annually, to be published in papers at the different ports of entry of the Pacific coast, warning all persons not entitled under the FRESH AND CURED MEATS !! law to engage in fur seal fishing Which will be sold at lowest rates, whole- or to commit depredations in the waters of Behring sea owned and controlled by the United States, and fixing penalties for any infraction of the law.

> The bill also provides that wi hin one year prior to the time when the lease heretofore made by the secretary of the treasury to the Alaska Commercial company of the right to engage in the taking of fur seals on the islands of St. Paul and St. George, or when any future similar lease expires or is surrendered, forfeited or terminated, the secretary of the treasury shall lease to proper responsi ble parties the right of taking fur seals on these islands at a annual rental of not less than \$50,000, and an additional sum of not less than \$3.50 for each seal skin taken and shipped from these islands during the continuance of any lease, to be paid into the treasury of the United States.

The bill also provides that it is unlawful to erect dams and other obstructions in any rivers iu Alaska with the purpose of preventing the ascent of salmon or other anadromous species to their spawning grounds. This is made punishable by a fine of not less than \$250 for each day of the continuance of the obstruction. A proposition is also made in the bill empowering the fish commissioners to institute an investigation into the habits, abundance and distribution of the salmon of Alaska, with a view to recommending to congress such additional legislation as may be necessary to prevent the impairment or exhaustion of the salmon and the placing of them under regular and permanent conditions of produc-




