The New Cabinet.

WASHINGTON, Mar. 6.—At 2 o'clock this afternoon Mr. Blaine came to the department of state. A curious crowd filled the hallway before the door of the secretary's room. Secretary Bayard cordially received Mr. Blaine. They exchanged courtesies while waiting the arrival of Justice Miller. Half an hour later he came, and Mr. Blaine repeated the oath of office in the presence of Secretary Bayard, Walker Blaine and Senator Sherman.
Secretary Proctor arrived at the war department about one o'clock. Ex-secretary Endicott and all the chiefs of bureaus were in waiting in the secretary's office. General Sherman also called on the retiring secretary during the morning and remained during the ceremonies incident to the change in the administration. After secretary Proctor had been duly installed, he received all the officers and employees in the department. General Schofield and all the principal officers of the department were separately introduced by ex-secretary Endicott.
