ORDINANCE NO. 1070.

An Ordinance to Provide for Licensing and Regulating Bar-Rooms and Drinking Shops Within The Corporate Limits of The City of Astoria.

The City of Astoria does ordain as follows: Section 1. That no person or persons shall in the City of Astoria, Clatsop county, Oregon, either directly or indirectly, in person or by another self, barter or sell, or knowingly permit to be sold, bartered or delivered, for or on his or her account, any wine, malt or spirituous liquors to be drunk on the premises occupied by him or them, without first obtaining a license as hereinafter provided.
