A poor run of fish was reported yesterday; one canneryman reported 2 to the boat, another 5, another 7; the fish are probably holding a convention out side.

The R. R. Thompson, which is now having new tubes put in her boiler, will soon go on the route again. Boats, like men, need rest and oil, and repairs occasionally.

An east bound Northern Pacific passenger train ran into a freight train six miles from Helena, Mont., last Tuesday, killing two tramps and fireman Chas. Green.

The steamer Polar Bear, arrived at Chikina, Alaska, 11 days from Astoria, including two days coaling at Nanaimo. Capt. John Olsen reports every body well.

The British bark Martha Foster, Buckingham master, 85 days from New Castle N. S. W. arrived yesterday afternoon with 1,100 tons coal consigned to Balfour, Guthrie & Co.

Eugene Bandell, the engineer in charge of the government water works at Vancouver barracks, fell and received injuries last Tuesday, resulting in almost instant death.

What's the matter with the board of delegates of the Astoria Fire Department? they have not met at all this year and there is lots of work to come before it, stir yourselves boys.

During the latter part of last week Miss Sarah Kindred, of Fort Stevens strained her back while lifting a wagon top, causing her to be very sick. The young lady is now improving.

Kelley's pile driver was yesterday towed down to Gray's bay, where two fish traps are to be put in. Fish traps are a leading industry nowadays. Dick Welcome is going to put in three more at Tongue Point.

Bishop Morris, Miss Laura Adair, Mrs. Goddell, and Mrs. Dr. Tuttle, each have a valuable quarter section of Herbert's unincorporated government land, near the Seaside house and have homesteaded it.

Seventeen boys captured and impounded a cow yesterday, and each one of the seventeen has served notice on Chief Barry not to pay the \$2.50 reward to any one of the other sixteen. Better give 'em all \$2.50 and encourage the boys.

Parties from Tacoma give it as their opinion that prices there have

reached the top notch, and that signs of a break are already visible; a good many have bought on margin, and when the call comes for more mud the tumble will be a rapid one.

The Samoa difficulty has cleared: The British bark Samoa has also cleared; the latter clearance was effected yesterday, she takes 67,865 tons wheat to Queensland; her cargo is worth \$37,100; the American schooner Falcon also cleared yesterday; she goes to Guaymas, with 310 ft. of lumber, worth \$3,720.

The Western Union Telegraph Co. is talking of extending the line on Astoria to Tillamook. Good! Another move necessary is to keep the office here open to 10 P. M. A fog bell is to be placed at Warren's point; the bell tower foundation will be of rock, 15x16 feet, and 13 ft. high, and on that will be a wooden building for the bell and its machinery. The Astoria lawn tennis club permanently organized Tuesday evening by the election of the following officers: W. A. Sherman, president; E. Z. Ferguson, vice president; O. F. Heilborn, secretary; F. S. Cook, treasurer. The grounds alongside the opera house have been fenced in and are being put in order. The first of a series of games will be played in about two weeks.

The closing episode in the record of the steamer Haytian Republic, as a trader between Boston and Haiti, occurred last Tuesday at Boston, Mass., when the craft that had been the object of so much disagreement was sold at auction for \$41,000. The purchaser, William Lewis, of New Bedford, will fit the Republic up for Behring sea and the Arctic ocean, as a whaling supply steamer. When built, she cost \$112,000.

"I saw Sol Abrahams in Roseburg," said a returned Astorian yesterday, "and he's struck it. Six years ago he bought some land in Spokane Falls for \$6,400. Well, while I was talking to him when I was in Roseburg, a boy gave him a telegram. It said 'Will you take \$310,000 for the property?' and was from Spokane Falls. Sol said, 'Not much I won't,' and put the telegram in his pocket with an air quite recherche."

There will, if all accounts are true be lively times around Kodiak, Alaska this summer. The Alaska Commercial Co., have a big dam there and two salmon canneries; other fishing companies have gone there, and around them are now more salmon canning companies than there are sites, and in case the Alaska Commercial company take a notion to pull out their dam and not pack any salmon there it will be interesting to know what the others propose to do about it.

Fraser, in his readable Sunday Budget, says the Tacoma Ledger pays \$400 a month for the privilege of keeping any other paper in Tacoma from getting the Associated Press dispatches. The people of Astoria pay \$800 a month for the privilege of being maligned and misrepresented in the papers. Funny how things work isn't it. Ask for \$800 or \$300 a month to be spent in an Astoria paper, for dispatches and it would paralyze folks, yet Astoria puts up \$800 a month for outside papers that never have a good word for the town or anyone in it.

United States marshal Atkins has brought down from Alaska five prisoners en route to San Quentin, California. Lewis Sharp, who murdered a man in western Alaska, was sentenced to the penitentiary. He was taken to Sitka via San Francisco, nearly 10,000 miles, for trial. Norman Duke goes for three years for robbing in Juneau; Louis Rankins, a Russian, to two years for selling whisky to Indians; Aaron, Indian chief of the Chilcat tribe, who is said to have murdered or caused to be killed eleven white miners at different times, who were entering the Yukon country, is sent to prison for four years, charged with mayhem. He defied twelve marshals to effect his arrest and gave them ten minutes to leave his mountain retreat. His tribe numbers 2,000 people. Kootwat, another Indian, goes to prison with his nose bitten off, the result of getting married, his bride biting off that member, whereupon he threw her in a bush fire, where she received severe injuries. The authorities have instructions to send all the prisoners to San Quentin serving over one year.
