Suicide of Milton Applegate.

Milton Applegate shot himself at his residence in Yoncalla, Or., Sunday at 4 p. m., June 23. He had been drinking heavily of pure alcohol three or four days, and his mind had become so worked up that he evidently knew not what he was doing. Going into the kitchen, he told his wife that he would kill himself, and walking into the next room, he deliberately took a Winchester rifle containing two cartridges, placed the muzzle against the left side of his head just above the ear, pulled the trigger and the cartridge instantly sped on its fatal course, coming out at the crown of his head. He fell on the floor and expired without a struggle. The wound was quite small and it required close examination to see where the ball came out at the crown of his head.

Mr. Applegate was buried at the Yoncalla cemetery, Monday, June 24, where a large number of relatives and friends attended. He leaves a wife and six small children. He was the youngest of sixteen children, Charles and Melinda Applegate being his parents. He was in his 35th year, was a very large and remarkably stout, healthy man. He had for years been in the habit of taking drinking spells, and had often expressed himself to friends as an intention to kill himself, alleging as a cause that he was a disgrace to his friends by drinking to such excess. When not under the influence of liquor he was a kind, genial gentleman, a good citizen, a generous neighbor, a kind husband and father.—Drain Echo.
