The first attempt was made with strychnine, but a second letter, dated several hours later, explains that the children were taken with such fits that he could not bear it, he shot them. Mrs. Johnson had died of poison, but both children were shot in the head.

The deceased is an old settler. The little girl was shot through the temples, destroying both eyes. She is still living, but with small chance of recovery.




