LAND OFFICE BUSINESS.

Entries at the Washington Office— Patents Issued.

The number of land entries pending in the commissioner's office at Washington, July 1st, was as follows:

Cases passed to patent, patents being made out, 7,904.

Homesteads, timber claims and desert lands posted, but not approved, 63,357.

Homesteads, timber claims and desert lands not touched at all, 55,140.

Pre-emption cases pending, 97,440.

Contests pending, 8,392.

Board of equitable adjudication, 8,391.

Alleged fraudulent cases, 11,556.

Total, over 250,000 cases, embracing 70,000,000 acres of land.

Patents have been issued as follows:

During Mr. Sparks' administration weekly average, 1,165.

During Mr. Stone's administration (the present commissioner), weekly average, 2,305.
