**Commissioner McDonald Coming.**  
Representatives of the United States fish commission are expected in Portland shortly. The party consists of Marshall McDonald, commissioner; Captain J. W. Collins, in charge of the fisheries division; Colonel John Gray, inspector of stations; J. J. O'Connor, chief clerk; George H. H. Moor, superintendent of distribution; E. C. Bryan, clerk; and August McDonald, son of the commissioner.

The party have been in Colorado to establish a trout hatching station on Evergreen lake near Leadville. Before coming to Portland they will visit the hatchery on the McLeod river, California, and increase the facilities so that a million young salmon a month may be turned back into the California rivers. The breeding station on the Clackamas will also be improved. From Portland the party will proceed to Port Townsend, W. T., so that commissioner McDonald may confer with the master of the United States steamer *Albatross*, with reference to the summer's work of that vessel in conducting fish culture along the coast.

Commissioner McDonald intends to devote the entire summer to exploring the various fishing grounds with a view to the development and improvement of the fish breeding industry.—*Oregonian*, 22.

**Another Dam Broken.**  
LANCASTER, O., July 21.—One of the most disastrous storms ever known in the Hocking valley culminated yesterday in the breaking of Sharp's dam at Sugar Grove, on the Hocking canal. The dam held in store a large body of water that supplied the lower levels of the canal. Heavy rains had filled the reservoir to its banks, when suddenly the dam gave way and the water went out through the valley, taking with it every movable object. For twenty miles the soil is plowed up. Trees, fences, crops and hundreds of head of live stock were swept away. No lives were lost, because the houses are situated on a bluff that overlooks the valley. But the canal for miles is a wreck, and thousands of feet of railroad track are washed away.
