An Eminent, Aged Jurist-

Decision That is a Hardship to Many Purchasers.

A recent ruling by the commissioner of the general lend office at Washington, D. C., is causing a great deal of trouble on D. C., is causing a great deal of trouble on this coast to many parties who have acquired title to government timber land during the past two years. The law, it seems, requires that in purchases of timber land final proof must be made within ninety days of the time of entry. Under the press of business at the Seattle land office this requirement has been disregarded. The date of final proof has been set four, five or six months, and in many cases as much as a year ahead of the time of making entry. This, it must be understood, was through no fault of the intending purchasers. The

fault of the intending purchasers. The officials of the Seattle office set the time for making final proof, and the purchasers fulfilled every requirement of the law so far as they were able to do so. so far as they were able to do so.

Under the new ruling all timber land entries made at the Seattle office in the past two or three years are null and void. Purchasers who had, as they supposed, successfully made final proof and had paid to the government the purchase price of their claim, find their entries

price of their claim, and their entries thrown out, and have the money which was accepted by the government returned to them, with a polite note stating why the clusive timber land has slipped from their grasp.

Though this ruling is in strict accord with the letter of the law, it will undoubtedly work a hardship in many cases. 
