Arch Street Improvement.

An Important Ruling. Acting land commissioner Stone has made an important ruling on the subject of the publication of the notice of a final proof of register at Rapid City, Dakota, reported to Stone that the Butte county State had notified him that they should increase the rates for publishing such notices from \$5 to \$10. As the law says such notices shall be published in papers nearest to the land indicated, and as this was the nearest paper the publishers seemed to be able to dictate, Stone, however, determined not to allow such imposition, and he directed the register to have such notices published in the nearest paper that would do so at reasonable rates and he (the commissioner) would see that the lands were not kept from patent by technicalities.
