

WINDOM'S GREAT WORK.

A nour fifteen years ago the busines necessity which more than any other pressed heavily upon the government was that of cheaper transportation from the western and southern states to the Atlantic seaboard. The cost of transportation was enormous. Farmers were burning their corn in the western states for fuel while the price in the east to those who needed it for fuel, was high. We had 60,000 miles of railroad then; we have 150,000 miles now. It cost 2 cents per ton per mile to transport freight then on our trunk railroads; it costs less than 1 cent per ton

per mile now. It cost 33 cents to transport a bushel of grain from Chicago to New York in 1873, all rail, and 16 cents then, and only 12 cents now. It was a great problem. One of the biggest this country ever had to face. A northwest-
