FIRE BRICK onist this morning printed the sal-mon pack of British Columbia to Hay, Oats, and Straw, Lime, Brick, Cement, Sand and Plaster totaling 379,000 cases, being 127,000 cases above the largest pack Wood Delivered to Order. Draying, Teaming and Express Business, of any previous year. Of this amount the northern canneries contributed 100,000 cases, the remainder being from Fraser river. Fish are still running freely on the latter, and some canneries will pack fall salmon. It is estimated that the year's pack will reach 420,000 cases. This has all been sold at \$5.50 to \$6.20, and calculating at \$7 per case makes a total value of over two millions and a half of dollars. 
