**The Behring Sea.**  
The New York Herald takes the ground that Behring sea is an open sea for four reasons: First, because geographers have so defined it; second, because writers on international law have so considered it; third, because England has so regarded it when she protested against the claim set up by Russia; and fourth, because the United States took a similar view of the Russian claim some fifty odd years ago. In the face of this showing the Russian government maintained its right of control over its remaining half of the sea up to 1882 against the world, and the world did not dispute it. In that year an order was issued by the Russian government to the effect that foreign vessels found trading, hunting, fishing, etc., in Russian waters (meaning the Russian half of Behring sea) shall be confiscated, both vessel and cargo, for the benefit of the government. There was nothing ambiguous about this order. It was made to apply to everybody of whatever nation who might trespass upon what Russia declared to be Russian waters. Still the Herald and several other papers take the British view of the American right of the sea in purchased from Russia after Russia had been possessed of it from the date of its discovery. The Herald sums up as follows:  
Hence against the present claim of the state department may be massed the authority of geographers, the principles of international law, the consensus of foreign nations and even our own diplomatic record. All these must be met and overcome by Mr. Blaine to defend successfully the seizure policy that has been inaugurated in Behring sea.  
The seizure policy which has been inaugurated is precisely the same policy that Russia announced in the order referred to, dated January 13, 1882.

Bids must state the price per lineal foot, of terra cotta pipe, price per man-hole, catch basin, branches, reference being had to the estimate and plans and specifications on file in the office of the Auditor and Police Judge. Work shall be completed within ninety days after the signing of the contract by the parties thereto. Bids must be strictly in accordance with printed blanks which will be furnished on application to the Auditor and Police Judge, particular attention being called to the note on said blanks. The contract will be awarded to the bidder who offers the lowest price, provided that the bidder is able to complete said work within the time specified, the contractor shall forfeit the sum of five dollars per day for each and every day required to complete said contract in excess of the time specified. The contractor or contractors when the contract is let shall enter into bond within forty-eight hours after receiving notice of the award with at least two good and sufficient sureties in the penal sum of \$1,000 for the true and faithful performance of all terms and conditions of said contract. Said bond shall also contain a provision, that such contractor or contractors shall and will hold the City of Astoria and the officers thereof free and harmless from any and all liabilities, or responsibility, from any loss or accident resulting from carelessness or neglect, during or resulting from such work, and the said bond shall be approved by the mayor of said city.
