A Monster Monarch Fellen.  
On Friday last, near the west bank of Austin creek, the ruthless woodman's ax laid low one of nature's kindest growths. For 1,000 years his vegetable majesty had lifted his proud head annually nearer the clouds, and taken upon himself, month by month, more and more of that colossal bulk which marks the true forest king. It measured thirty-eight feet in girth three feet above the ground, and was 310 feet high. It took two most accomplished axmen, with the best of modern tools, nearly a day and a quarter to cut it away to the point where its own vast weight caused it to topple to its fall.
