

A Monster Monarch Fallen.

On Friday last, near the west bank of Austin creek, the ruthless wood-man's ax laid low one of nature's kingliest growths. For 1,000 years his vegetable majesty had lifed his proud head annually nearer the clouds, and taken upon himself, month by month, more and more of that colossal bulk which marks the true forest king. It measured thirty-eight feet in girth three feet above the ground, and was 310 feet high. It took two most accomplished ax-men, with the best of modern tools, nearly a day and a quarter to cut it away to the point where its own vast weight caused it to topple to its fall. With that wonderful skill, which only long experience gives, these veteran axmen, under the direction of foreman Soper, laid the monster so exactly as to drive a stake previously set 200 feet from its base, on the bank of the creek. Even at that point the tree was twenty feet around, and the upper 100 feet crashed down across the creek, swept down across the telegraph line, snapped two telegraph poles short off. and fell across the railroad track of the North Pacific Coast railroad. The fall shook the earth in a local earthquake felt half a mile off, sent up clouds of dust, completely obscuring the great trunk, and sent forth a report like heavy artillery. - San Francisco Alla.
