The fact that more than 150,000 men are out on strike in London is probably the most momentous event in the social condition of England that has taken place in that country since the hungry classes threatened the life of the duke of Wellington on account of his opposition to the repeal of the corn laws. The great danger of the present agitation is manifested in the forms of industry represented by the malcontents. It is not merely a case of hungry laborers out of employment, clamoring for bread, a large proportion of whom had hovered perpetually on the borderland of poor-house relief. It is no huge political demonstration made in the interest of men who promise to carry certain popular measures in parliament. It is an agitation which has been in preparation since the Trafalgar Square riots two years ago, and is meant to impress not only the government, but the privileged classes of the English people, that workmen who are really oppressed and deprived of rights have at last found out their power, and that now they propose to use it.

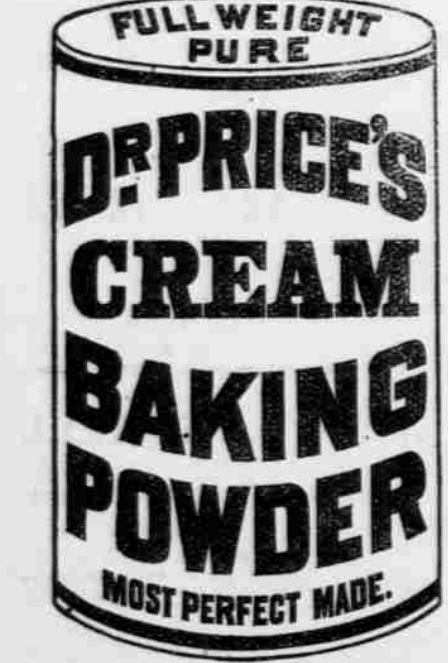
