The men quarreled in a sloop anchored in the bay off the Morse cannery wharf, over the division of the proceeds of a fishing expedition, when Suttino drew a pocket knife and plunged it into Sare's heart. The murderer leaped overboard, swam ashore and escaped. The other occupants of the sloop moved it to the wharf, and helped Sare ashore. The wounded man staggered 200 feet to a saloon, and entering opened his shirt, and exposing the bleeding cut in his breast to a dozen occupants of the place. "Look here boys, see how I am cut," he said. Then, before anyone could speak, he fell to the floor, dead. Both Sare and Suttino came to Seattle three months ago from Astoria.
