In Clarke county so far the Republican state ticket is elected two to one. Pierce county gives the Re-publican state ticket a large majority. The Republicans carry everything in

The Republicans carry everything in the county. Thurston county gives the constitution over 1,000 majority. The Republican majority on the whole ticket in Thurston is 450. Lewis gives a strong majority for the constitution and the Republican state ticket, and elects the whole Republi-can county ticket. 
