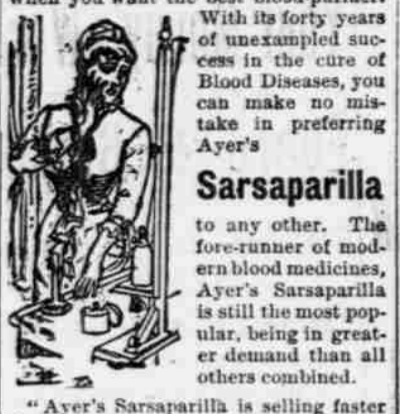

Specials to The Astorian. Jim Turk Leaves Astoria Again Will Not Come Back Any More, (Maybe.)

PORTLAND, Oct. 8.—James Turk today said, "I've left Astoria for good and I'm going to stay in town where I shall furnish crews to ship captains at the regular rate allowed by law, which is \$40 advance money and \$10 for shipping. I wanted to inaugurate that scheme at Astoria, but the boys threatened to take my life. They were getting \$87.50 a head for every man shipped, and a reduction of \$37.50 would make quite a difference." "You don't mean that you were afraid of being murdered?" asked an ASTORIAN reporter. "Indeed I was. I am not as young and spry as I was, and don't want to take any desperate chances. I'll never go back to Astoria, I want to dispose of all my property there even if I have to do it at a sacrifice."

Late yesterday afternoon the room of Carl Schmidt in the Esmond hotel was robbed of about \$400 worth of samples. On the 22nd inst., a banquet will be given in honor of Hon. Sol Hirsch, U. S. minister to Turkey, at the Concordia club. The committee having the affair in charge are Donald MacLeay, president of the board of trade, Col. C. F. Beebe, P. Lowengart, David Dunne, Ed. Rothschild, Col. McCracken, and Ben. Selling.

Yesterday morning about two o'clock W. A. Richardson, a dairyman living near the car shops in East Portland was robbed of a fine gold watch, jewelry and money to the amount of \$750.

G. W. Anderson the forger and the lover of Sadie Kirby, an actress, had a hearing upon the charge preferred by John Landgraf, for obtaining money under false pretense to-day. The testimony was short and conclusive, and although counsel moved for dismissal the court would not entertain the motion and held him in \$500 bonds to await the action of the grand jury.

The Southern Pacific train from San Francisco which should have arrived here this morning has been delayed by the derailment of the southern bound train last night and the mail will not reach this city until about eight o'clock this evening. This afternoon Dr. A. J. Giesey examined Mrs. Annetta B. Averill and recommended her commitment to the asylum. This is his second commitment and her affliction arises from overstudy of occultism.

Six fishermen were fined \$50 each by a Stockton, Cal., police justice for seining salmon in the San Joaquin river.

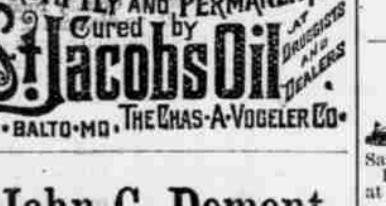
