Spirits of Unrest Among the Western Farmers.
The rapid advance of wealth in the United States is the boast of the people. But the farmers feel that this great advance has been made by other classes than themselves. It is conceded that the lands of Illinois have declined in aggregate value during the last ten years several hundred million dollars. The result of this decline is effecting an important change in the rural population. The ambitious boys and girls are leaving the farm, and the farms themselves are passing into new ownerships representing less intelligence and less aspiration toward higher conditions of life. The more thoughtful farmers are very much absorbed just now in studying the causes of this decline of prosperity, and the apparent decline of those conditions which alone contribute to prosperity. There is an argument of the politicians and middlemen that confuses the farmer. It is to the effect that farm products are sold at as high a price, and that marketing, clothing and machinery are bought at lower prices than formerly. But the farmer claims, and with justice, that we are living in a new civilization, and that he, like all other producers, has a right to the best that it affords. - Illinois Corr. Boston Traveller.
