A Prosperous Community. Deep River lies in the western end of Waukena County, and is navigable for a distance of five miles by steamboat from the mouth.

Deep River has been settled for thirty years, Mr. George Gorcy being the pioneer settler, and who is still a resident here. In the last five years Deep River has settled up very fast, there being now on the River about eighty settlers.

Deep River is divided into three school districts, with three good school houses, the total number of scholars attending school being sixty-five. The term of school lasts for three months, and is sometimes held longer by private subscription.

Deep River, surrounded as she is with all these natural advantages, and peopled with a live, wide-awake community, will step to the front in the near future, as one of the largest and best business points in the county.
