Complaints To The Governor.

Complaints have been made to Governor Penoyer from parties residing on head waters both of the Yaquina and Alsea rivers, that this season salmon were prevented from ascending such rivers by the building of a dam without fishways, and by the stretching of nets across the entire rivers. Both proceedings are clearly misdemeanors under section 1,950 of the Oregon code, and the governor has referred the matter to the prosecuting attorney of the Second judicial district, for official action, and at the same time requested the parties writing to him to co-operate with such officers at the next term of the circuit court of Benton county for the punishment of the offenders.
