For the Pool Killer.

A patent nostrum called "Microbe-killer" is "a cheap and nasty decoction." An analysis made of the stuff showed its composition to be as follows:
Oil of vitrol (impure)..... 4 drachms
Muriatic acid (impure)..... 1 drachm
Red wine, about..... 1 ounce
Well or spring water..... 1 gallon

This is said to cost about five cents, and it is sold at \$3 a gallon, which certainly allows a sufficient margin for profit. The chief expense in putting it up is the value of the jug.

The president of the New York Pharmaceutical association has, in a published article, demonstrated the fallacy of the theory upon which this mixture is based.

It is said that postmaster-general Wanmaker means to recommend free postal delivery in all places having 8,000 inhabitants or \$8,000 annual receipts for postage. But since every reduction of limit so far has more than paid for itself, why not extend the free delivery still further, say to all places having 1,000 inhabitants within half a mile of the post-office?

The total amount of pensions disbursed for the Pacific coast from pension agent Allen's office during September was \$225,000. This covers 8,000 pensions, while four years ago there were only 2,900 on the Pacific coast. Of these 827 are Mexican veterans who have only been in receipt of pensions since the passage of the Mexican veterans act.
