AFRAID OF BATTLE, BUT NOT OF DEATH.

Talking about courage and cowardice at the club the other day, Colonel Dudley remarked that he always had as much sympathy with a cowardly man as he had admiration for a brave one, for he thought nerve was a natural attribute to man just like a taste for art, the gift of acquiring languages or musical talent.

"I had a case in my own regiment, the Nineteenth Indiana," continued the colonel: "A young fellow by the name of Woods, who was bright, well educated and came from one of the most respectable families in Indiana. He was a good camp soldier, but we were never able to get him into battle.

The sound of explosives or the sight of blood would throw him into hysterics of fear, and when he was placed in a position of danger he would become uncontrollable, temporarily insane. Finally he deserted, went over into the rebel lines, and then came back with a suit of gray, expecting to be sent to some northern prison as a confederate. But he was identified, tried by court martial, and sentenced to be shot as a deserter.

He was shot, and the story of his execution, for the first time in his life, he behaved like a hero. He refused to have his eyes bandaged, but stood up beside his coffin and looked straight into the barrels of the muskets that were pointed at his heart. He made an able mortem statement in which he claimed his desertion was not due to lack of loyalty, but to bodily fear. He thought he could get out of the army that way, and I believe his words were true."
