THE ALASKA SALMON PACK.

Over Half a Million Cases Packed.

SAN FRANCISCO, Nov. 10.—The steamer *Huylen Republic*, which arrived yesterday from Kodiak, Alaska, brought down a cargo of 18,500 cases of salmon. She left nine men on St. Paul Island, to take care of the canneries for the winter; three at Kasiluk, three at Kodiak, and three at Alitak. She brought down 295 passengers, the majority of whom were Chinese. The *Huylen Republic's* charter with the Kodiak Packing company will expire with the termination of this trip. It is understood here that she has been chartered to run between here and Puget sound. The arrival of this steamer closes the salmon season in Alaska, as she was the last vessel up north. In the early part of the season the salmon run was very light, but as the season advanced the run improved, and the result has been that more fish have been packed this year than ever before. Notwithstanding this the year has been a profitless one to many. A number of new canneries were started this year in Alaska and considerable money has been sunk. Some of the old companies are among the sufferers, while some new companies have thriven, notably the Arctic Packing company and the Alaska Improvement company. The head, although it has fallen somewhat short in comparison with other years. The entire Alaska pack for the season is as follows:

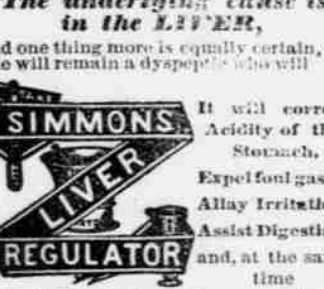

MINNEAPOLIS, Minn., Nov. 10.—In 1886 Mrs. Butts was in possession of a boarding house in this city. She had but recently moved from Chicago, where her husband had died shortly before, leaving herself and two small children, a boy and a girl. Among the boarders was Raphael Price, who became madly infatuated with the widow, and upon her refusal to marry him suddenly disappeared, taking with him the boy Frankie. The affair caused quite a sensation at the time.

Nothing was heard of Price until recently, when chief of police Brackett got word of him at Lakeport, Cal., where he had placed the boy in good hands. The mother had in the mean time moved to Oregon, and a dispatch received here to-day says that the child has been once more restored to its mother, who is now a professional nurse in the city of Portland.

A SENSATIONAL SERMON.

How a Preacher Astonished His Congregation.

MINNEAPOLIS, Minn., Nov. 10.—The Rev. J. A. Graham, pastor of the Holy Trinity Episcopal Church, astonished his congregation this morning by assuming the role of Robert Elsner, renouncing Christianity and denying the Bible and the church and their teachings.

So cleverly did the gentleman play the part that a startling scene ensued. Many of his listeners were in tears. Some thought that he was crazy, and all were impressively shocked at his words. His strange discourse was spoken in a very impressive manner, and not a member doubted that he meant all he said, but he did not. He was trying to show the people the evil results of indifference in religion, so that they might get an idea how terrible it was to hear religion denounced.

His main point was to make them see the necessity of clinging to the faith. It was a strange way of getting at the people, but it had its effect and gave them an unusual shaking up on religious questions.
