A Rogues' Gallery.

The Salem Statesman of Thursday has the following: Superintendent Bookman is making arrangements for establishing of the Oregon state penitentiary, what is known as the rogues' gallery. Every state in the Union, perhaps, except Oregon and Washington, have such, and Oregon proposes to keep up with them. Arrangements are being made by which a first-class camera will be secured and when a new prisoner is introduced at the penitentiary he will be photographed immediately upon his arrival. He will be shaved and dressed in stripes, when the camera will be turned upon him for a second time. And during the term of his servitude he will be photographed in different styles of beard. These photographs will be preserved together with an accurate description of the man, and should he ever be wanted again it will not be difficult to identify him. A printing press and type will be purchased and the description published in pamphlet form. It is proposed to raise funds for the purchase of camera, type, presses, etc., among the sheriffs of the different counties. For this purpose the superintendent is about to issue a circular letter to the sheriffs of the different counties of the state. The idea of establishing a rogues' gallery is a good one and should be carried into completion.
