A SAMPLE OF THE DISPATCHES

That The Astorian Used to Get One Hundred Years Ago.

NEW ORLEANS, Dec. 7.—The remains of Jefferson Davis are lying in state in the council chamber of the city hall. The coffin rests upon a catafalque devoid of much ornamentation. The casket has a silver plate upon which is the simple inscription: "Jefferson Davis at rest," with the date of his death. Badges of confederate associations, flags of Washington artillery, which were carried through the war, and a bunch of wheat and a pair of crossed Spanish daggers fastened together with purple ribbon, are the only other ornaments. The darkened room is partially lit up by clusters of electric lights, their brilliancy dimmed by the sable drapery. Soldiers in uniform stand guard; stacks of arms and cannons fill the corners of the chamber, and all around the walls are rows of plants and shrubbery. Since early this morning people have been pouring in to obtain a look at the dead. All classes are represented in the procession by the bar. A number of colored people were noticed in the crowd. Marked mourning is general and every place of prominence in the city put on black. A noteworthy event this morning was a telegram sent by mayor Shiloh to secretary of war Proctor, officially notifying him of the death of ex-secretary Davis, and the date of the funeral.

DOM PEDRO IN PORTUGAL.
LISBOA, Dec. 7.—The steamer *Magia* with ex-emporer Dom Pedro, of Brazil, and party on board, and flying the old Brazilian flag, arrived in the Tagus this morning. She anchored off Belem, a suburb of Lisbon opposite the Lazzarato, but was not to undergo quarantine. The party came ashore immediately, and landed at the naval arsenal. Before they left the steamer she was boarded by king Carlos, who extended a warm welcome to the ex-emporer. Dom Pedro is in excellent spirits and appears not to have suffered by the recent events in Brazil.
It is said he intends to issue a manifesto to the Brazilian people. Dom Pedro declines to discuss the recent events in Brazil. Count Du intends to go to Spain on a visit to duke De Montpensier. Dom Pedro will probably remain in Lisbon a few days and then proceed to Paris.

AGAINST CHINESE IMMIGRATION.
OTTAWA, Ont., Dec. 7.—The following telegram has been received by premier McDonald in behalf of the bread winners and electors of this city: "I earnestly protest against any modification of Chinese restriction act; the measure is a necessary protest against the dangerous invasion of the worst form of debased Mongolian heathenism which tends only to degrade labor and impoverish the country. A SHOCKING ACCIDENT.

A Boy's Head Sawed in Two At Holt's Mill.

Fritz Johnson, the twelve year old son of Mrs. Johnson, residing in the vicinity of the Astoria Packing Co's cannery, met with a frightful death at 4:30 yesterday afternoon. The little fellow had been in the habit of going to Holt's mill and gathering up sawdust, as he takes home. In one part of the mill is an edge saw, part of it above, and the greater part of it below the surface of a table in which the saw works. The boy had gone under this table in his quest for sawdust and it is supposed not remembering anything of the swiftly revolving saw over his head, raised up quickly. James McComber, who was working in another part of the room heard a smothered cry and a peculiar grating noise and rushing to the spot, found the prostrate form of the unfortunate lad, splattered with blood from a hideous laceration of his head, the upper half of the poor little fellow's head having been sawed off.
The inanimate form of the child was removed to coroner Surprenant's undertaking rooms and thence to the house of the heart broken mother, who has the sympathy of the community in her terrible bereavement.
