

Winnipeo, Dec. 12.—A citizen just arrived from the Pacific coast tells of a thrilling accident to the Canadian Pacific through express in the mountains. A rail gave way at a point on the mountain side high above the Columbia river. The engine passed over safely, but the two coaches following swung about and toppled over. The bank was almost perpendicular, and the cars would have tumbled several hundred feet into the river had it not been that the coupling twisted around and held the tremendous weight. There were the cars, one with its load of passengers suspended over the abyss. The weight of the engine and balance of the train prevented the suspended cars draw-ing the whole train down.

The suspense was dreadful. Th frightened passengers were compelled to remain in their perilous position until the train hands built a platform around and underneath the hanging cars, enabling all to make their escape The place where the accident occurred is considered the most dangerous in the mountains.

Great Profits of Elevators.

The purchase by English syndicates of 75 grain elevators on the Chicago & Northwestern railroad, and of eight large elevators owned by Munger, Wheeler & Co. in Chicago, has brought to light the enormous profits realized by the elevators, and gives at least a partial explanation of the im poverishment of the western farmers The promoters of the English com pany which purchased the 75 elevators, in offering the shares for sale in London, state that the profits in 1880 were 28 per cent. of the purchas price, in 1887, 22 per cent., and in 1888 30 per cent. As a result all the shares were promptly taken. Even the fig-ures do not give a full view of the percentage of profit on the investment, for the elevators are sold to the English middlemen at a price far exceeding the amount originally in vested in them, the difference repre senting the value of the monopolyor, in other words, the value of the exclusive right of milking the farmers dry. These middlemen must have a fat commission and the companie which buy from them are capitalized at a sum far in excess of the purchas price. Thus the English investor will expect these dividends on a still larger sum than was represented by the American owners and will attempt to squeeze still more out of the farmers

An Ocean Lumber Raft.

The Fort Bragg Lumber company of San Francisco, is now about to try the Goldy boom, which has been in successful operation on the great lakes for about three years. According to this plan, a raft will be con-structed of thirty-two pieces, each composed of seven sticks chained together and arranged in a semicircle, within which the logs that are to be towed will be placed. The Goldy boom will be supported by strong cross chains and for and aft chains. By this means 1,500,000 feet of lum ber can be brought down, or much more, if the circle is enlarged. The largest Joggins raft, constructed in the shape of a cigar, contained 3,500, 000 feet of logs. If this method is successful, a large sawmill will b built on the water front, probably at Alameda. It is said that it will reduce the expense of shipment \$2 or more a thousand feet.


