

If he just wants the timber on the

land, says the Portland Examiner, all he has got to do is to bring a sawmill out here and proceed to cut it down and sell it, provided he does it in a large quantity. If in large quantity and if he is arrested for it, the case will be known in the United States court as one of "cutting timber on government land," and he will be made to pay for a few thousand feet and permitted to go on his way. If, however, he goes to work on a small scale, he is very likely to be criminally prosecuted and sent to the peniten tiary. Two hundred thousand acres, the amount mentioned by the Chicago attorney, will insure him safety if he can get away with it, or even the half of it.
