

NEARLY A MILLION GUESSES.

ne of Them Very Close Nearly a million guesses of Nellie Nearly a million guesses of Nellie Bly's time around the world were sent to the World. F. W. Stevens, of 193 Second Avenue, New York city, makes the nearest guess and is therefore the winner of the free trip to Europe. His guess was 72 days, 6 hours, 11 minutes and 142-5 seconds, and was just a fraction over the exand was just a fraction over the exact time which was certified to by G. A. Avery and C. C. Hayhn, of the Manhattan Athletic club, and Robert Stoll, of the New York Athletic club.

Mr. Stevens' guess was received in the World office the day before Miss Bly reached Chicago.

The next nearest guesser was Tho as Halton, of New York, who made his venture when Miss Bly was on the Pacific ocean, and was only three-fifths of a second out of the way. More than 20 contestants came within 15 seconds of the time. As the circumnavigator neared the American coast the letters with the coupon guesses ponred into the office and 33 assistants from the postoffice were put on to assist in examining and classifying the coupons. It took 107 hours fying the coupons. It took 107 hours without one minute's intermission to complete the sorting, and in that time 132 men had examined 927,433 coupons, of which 926,300 came by mail, 1133 by express and 223 by special messengers.
