Fish—Salmon, 8 to 10 cents per lb.; smelt, 10 cents; flounder, 6 cents; tom cod, 6 cents.
Poultry—Chickens, 75 cents; Oysters—Shoalwater bay, \$2.85 per sack.
Meats—Beef, to the trade, 9 to 11 cents per lb. dressed; 4¢ to 4½¢ on foot. Hogs, 7 cents dressed. Veal, 7 cents dressed. Mutton, 10¢ to 10½ cents dressed.
