NEW TO-DAY Ross' Opera House. Tuesday Evening, April 15. INTERESTING LECTURE, BY His Grace, The Rev. Archbishop Gross, OF Portland, Entitled, "A Visit to France and Rome." For the Benefit of Young Men's Institute, No. 106.

Says yesterday's Oregonian: The Oregon Railway Extensions company, of which Hon. Henry Failing, of this city, is president, and Hon. Joseph Simon secretary, yesterday filed at Olympia, Wash., supplementary articles of incorporation empowering it to build 3,000 miles of new lines in the Northwest. The company will gridiron Oregon, Washington, Idaho and Montana with lines, all of which will bring business to Portland. The main line will run from Portland to Blaine, Whascom county, right under the shadow of the British flag. Seattle, Tacoma and other Sound cities will be connected with the system by branch lines. The Columbia will be bridged at Vancouver. The Washington legislature, which recently adjourned, granted necessary authority. This road will make all the country between this city and Blaine tributary to Portland.
