MAKE RECLAMATION.
THE repeated bursting of the hose last Monday night brings to mind the fact that the sellers of hose to the city council guarantee it for four years—and that Astoria has never put in a claim for reclamation yet. The manufacturers of fire hose expect to have some of it burst—and charge accordingly. It would be a good idea to stand upon our contract right in this matter, and have them make good the defective hose. In any event it is manifest that strong hose, able to stand ordinary pressure should be ready for use. Our efficient fire department will find itself badly crippled some day or night, in the hour of utmost need, unless this very important matter receives attention.

ACCORDING to the latest report regarding the Behring sea question, the treaty drawn up between the United States and England will recognize that body of water as closed, in the diplomatic sense, during the four months of the sealing period, while being open through the remainder of the year. During the close season it will be under the sole jurisdiction of the United States. As the adequate protection of the seal is the principal consideration in this controversy with us, this sort of settlement would give complete satisfaction to the people.
