### A PROCLAMATION.

THE FOLLOWING PROVISIONS OF the laws of the United States are hereby published for the information of all concerned: Section 156, Revised Statutes, Chapter 2, Title 22, enacts that: "No person shall kill any other man, woman, child, or infant, or any other fur-bearing animal, within the limits of Alaska Territory, or in the waters thereof; and every person guilty thereof, shall, for each offense, be fined not less than two hundred nor more than one thousand dollars, or imprisoned not more than six months, or both; and all vessels, their tackle, apparel, furniture and cargo, found engaged in violation of this section, shall be forfeited, but the Secretary of the Treasury shall have power to authorize the killing of any such man, woman, child, or other fur-bearing animal, except fur seals, under such regulations as he may prescribe, and it shall be the duty of the Secretary to prevent the killing of any fur seal, and to provide for the execution of the provisions of this section until it is otherwise provided by law, nor shall he grant any special privileges under this section."

For the first time in the history of the state Clatsop county elects a state senator and two representatives, a fair apportionment, and it is but justice to say that to the efforts of state senator Gray, in the legislature this result was largely due.

The settlement of the Montana contest gives the Republicans ten majority in the senate. This is the broadest margin which any party has had in this body since the forty-fourth congress, which lasted from 1875 to 1877. In the senate of that congress the Republicans had a majority of 13. The Republican majorities in the senate in subsequent congresses were: Three in the forty-fifth, four in the forty-eighth, eight in the forty-ninth and two in the fiftieth. In the senate of the forty-sixth congress, which was the only one controlled by the Democrats since before the war, that party had a majority of nine, while the next senate was tied between the parties.
