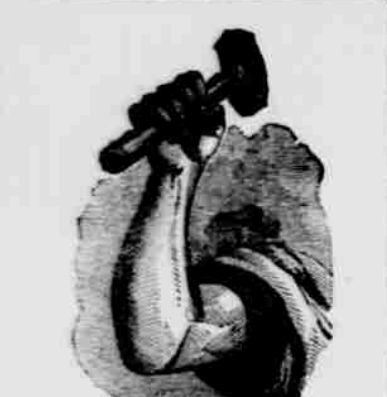

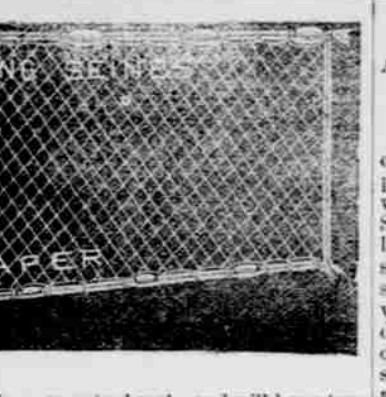

A PROCLAMATION. THE FOLLOWING PROVISIONS OF THE LAWS OF ALASKA ARE HEREBY published for the information of all concerned:

Section 1056, Revised Statutes, Chapter 3, Title 22, enacted that: "No person shall kill any other fur-bearing animal, within the limits of Alaska Territory, or in the waters there, and every person guilty thereof shall, for each offence, be fined not less than two hundred dollars, or not more than one thousand dollars, or imprisoned not more than six months, or both; and all vessels, their crews and every person on board, engaged in violation of this section, shall be held liable for the same."

Section 3 of the act entitled: "An act to provide for the protection of the salmon fisheries of Alaska," approved March 2, 1899, provides that:

"Section 3. That section 1056 of the Revised Statutes of the United States is hereby declared to include and apply to all the doings of the fishery of the waters of Behring Sea, and it shall be the duty of the President at a timely season in each year to issue his proclamation to that effect, and to be published for one month at least in one newspaper (if any such newspaper be published) in the waters of Behring Sea, warning all persons engaged in any violation of the provisions of said section, and he shall also cause one or more vessels of the United States to diligently cruise said waters and arrest all persons and seize all vessels found to have been engaged in any violation of the laws of the United States therein."

Now, therefore, I, BENJAMIN HARRISON, President of the United States, pursuant to the above recited statutes, hereby warn all persons against entering the waters of Behring Sea within the dominion of the United States for the purpose of violating the provisions of said section, and he shall also cause one or more vessels of the United States to diligently cruise said waters and arrest all persons and seize all vessels found to have been engaged in any violation of the laws of the United States therein."

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the United States to be affixed.

Done at the City of Washington, this fifteenth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-nine.
