A PROCLAMATION.

THE FOLLOWING PROVISIONS OF the laws of the United States are hereby published for the information of all con-The laws of the United States are hereby published for the information of all concerned:

Section 1956, Revised Statutes, Chapter 3, Title 23, enacts that: "No person shall kill any otter, mink, marten, sable, or fur seal, or other fur-bearing animal, within the limits of Alaska Territory, or in the waters thereof; and every person guilty thereof, shall, for each offence, be fined not less than two hundred nor more than one thousand dollars, or imprisoned not more than six months, or both; and all vessels, their tackle, apparel, furniture and cargo, found engaged in violation of this section, shall be forfeited, but the Secretary of the Treasury shall have power to anthorize the killing of any such mink, marten, sable, or other furbearing animal, except fur seals, under such regulations as he may prescribe, and ff shall be the duty of the Secretary to prevent the killing of any fur seal, and to provide for the execution of the provisions of this section until it is otherwise provided by law, nor shall he grant any special privileges under this section.

Section 3 of the act entitled: "An act to provide for the protection of the salmon fisheries of Alaska," approved March 2, 1889,

lisheries of Alaska," approved March 2, 1889, provides that:

"Section 3. That section 1956 of the Revised Statutes of the United States is hereby declared to include and apply to all the dominion of the United States in the waters of Behring Sea, and it shall be the duty of the President at a timely season in each year to issue his proclamation, and cause the same to be published for one month at least in one newspaper (if any such there be) published at each United States port of
