At the junction of the North and South forks, five miles above the head of Nehalem bay and nine miles from the ocean, Mr. E. T. Davies, a Michithe occan, Mr. E. T. Davies, a Michigan man, who owns a large tract of land in that vicinity, has laid off a site for a town to be called Saginaw, for the well known town and river in Michigan, which is intended to be the center of the lumber business in that section. The Albany and Astoria railroad is surveyed through the townsite, and the Astoria and South Coast road passes about eighteen miles

road passes about eighteen miles further up the river. Mr. Hillman said he should bring out a number of men from the east to the prospects for that section very promising. As the government has appropriated \$10,000 for improving the bar at the mouth of the river and removing snags so that sea-going vessels can enter, and further appropri ations will follow, inducements are be ing offered to secure sawmills at Sagwithin a few miles of the city.




