Surveys of Land.

Surveyor General Cavanaugh went down the Sound yesterday morning on business connected with the sarveys of lands in western Washington.
"Contracts have been let," Mr. Cavanaugh said before leaving The Tacoma
for the down Sound boat, "for surscret Safet Certain: veying nearly all of the 24 townships authorized by the federal appropria tions for that purpose. As each township contains 23,000 acres, over 500,000 acres of the public domain will be surveyed under this year's appropriations. By what is known as the augmented rate, which I se cured last winter while at Washington city, I am authorized to pay from 6 to 8 cents per acre or \$1,500 per townhip for making these surveys. The imber in this country west of the ascade mountains is too heavy to allow the surveying crews to make much headway. This year the surveys will be made in Lewis, Cowlitz, Pacific, Chehalis, Pierce, King, Sno-homish, Skagit, Whitney and Jefferson counties, two townships being surveyed in the last named county.
