MARINE NEWS AND NOTES.

Interesting Items Regarding Vessels.

The steamer Gen. Canby is being newly painted, and put in fine condition.

The steamer Louise Vanantla went up this morning towing a large barge heavily loaded with pottery clay from Young's river.

The steamer Orsvego came down the river yesterday, with a barge loaded with brush and fascines for the government jetty at the mouth of the Columbia.

The steamer No Wonder, Capt. Jas. Whitcomb, will go up the river this morning with a raft of logs from Lewis & Clarke river, containing over half a million feet of lumber.

The steam tender Manzanita, Capt. Richardson, left here yesterday afternoon at 3:30 for San Francisco. The steamer started from Main street dock, went up as far as the U. Some of the Chinese will be employed here at the different canneries, and a few will go back to the Alaska canneries on the steamer City of Topeka on her next trip. The Tam O'Shanter will take on a load of lumber here for Redondo Beach, California.
