The *New Era*, a paper printed in South Dakota, has made the discovery that the "original package" decision doesn't count in that state. The reason is because prohibition is in the state constitution. Congress passed the enabling act; the people of South Dakota adopted a constitution with a prohibition section—a section authorizing the legislature to prohibit the liquor traffic; the president issued his proclamation pursuant to law declaring the state admitted to the Union, with its constitution, of course, and the state legislature has exercised its constitutional power to prohibit. After reciting these facts the *New Era* exclaims: "Congress and the president make laws for the supreme court to enforce. Can the supreme court nullify the constitution of South Dakota? We think not. Our constitution must stand superior to any Dred Scott interstate commerce opinion of the supreme court, or else we are not entitled to statehood."

If a case should arise involving the points made by the *New Era*, the supreme court might hold that congress by virtually approving the constitution of South Dakota had surrendered its power to regulate commerce in liquors between the people of South Dakota and the people of other states, or it might hold otherwise. Be that as it may, it is certain that the supreme court is not bound by anything and everything that congress and the president may choose to do, nor is it bound by any state constitution. If it were, nobody could complain of the Dred Scott decision, for that simply upheld an act of congress. The court is bound by the constitution of the United States. If congress passes an act which is plainly in conflict with the national constitution the court will not uphold it.

Suppose, for illustration, the constitution of South Dakota containing a provision authorizing the state legislature to pass laws impairing the obligation of contracts, or a law making every man's due-bill a legal tender in payment of his debts. The supreme court would not be bound by such a provision, nor would an act of congress admitting the state to the union with a constitution containing such a provision make the provision binding upon the court. Neither a state constitution nor an act of congress can nullify the constitution of the United States. If the constitution of South Dakota contains anything plainly repugnant to the constitution of the Nation it is void, and the supreme court will no doubt so declare if the matter comes before it in proper form and manner for judicial determination.

The house bill to incorporate the North River Bridge company, which passed the United States senate June 25th, is a step toward the connection of New York city and Jersey city by the biggest span ever erected. The bridge will have a capacity for ten railroad tracks across it, with proportionate accommodations for foot-passengers and wagons. The estimated cost of the bridge proper—including towers, cable and anchorage—is \$15,000,000; approaches of stone and iron and appurtenances, \$11,000,000; incidentals, \$14,000,000.

San Francisco Salmon Shipments.

The salmon shipments by water from San Francisco in June compare as follows:

The shipments last month embraced 1,961 cs to New York, 1,075 cs to Australia, 1,775 cs to England and 426 pkgs to the Hawaiian islands. The canned salmon shipments from this port by water for the first six months were distributed principally as follows:
