A GIGANTIC SCHEME.

The Waters of Snake River to be Diverted for the Benefit of the Great Salt Lake Basin.

Certain Salt Lake parties, says the Boise Statesman, have been trying to work up a scheme for diverting the waters of Snake river into irrigating canals for the benefit of the Great Salt Lake basin. The scheme has no national foundation and cannot have the slightest hope of ever materializing but the discussion that has grown out of the matter has furnished the Wood River Times with a text upon which to construct the following neat bit of a sermon: The Snake river valley and tributary region will, ere another century elapses, contain a population of 40,000,000 to 50,000,000 souls. Surely such a population can only be main ained by the use of the waters of the Snake for irrigating or manufacturing. The Snake will not half suffice for this, even though every drop of water flowing into or in it, from its source to its mouth, shall be availed of. Even now, the navigation of the Columbia is greatly impeded because of the low stage of water at all seasons, but especially in the summer and fall; and the national government is spending sums of money aggregating millions of dollars to improve its navigation.

Were Idahoans to be stupid enough

to permit the Snake river to be di-verted to the Great Salt Lake, or to be put to any use except that manifestly intended by nature, they would be fit candidates for a lunatic asylum. But Idaho is not the only state interested in maintaining undisturbed the flow of the Snake river to the sea. When the question shall be up for public discussion, or for legislative inquiry, the states of Washington and
