The Fastest Torpedo Boat

New York, Aug. 26.—A dispatch from Washington says, that according to the *Journal*, published by the Society of Navat Engineers for the current quarter, the fastest torpedo boat extant is a little torpedo dispatch boat built after the new type introduced by Schicherau, of Germany, for the Russian government. She is similar in principle to the Italian boats Agutla, Niblio and Falko. The hull is 152 seven inches long, seven-feet beam, and about displacement. engines are twin screws, tripple ex-pansion, of about 2,300 indicated borse power. There are two loco-motive boilers. It is officially re-ported that she made a mean speed during six runs over a measured mile, of 27.4 knots. 
